



Dear Ticket-holder,

Please find below important safety regulations for the Bob Kerr Irish Senior Cup Final to be played in North County CC on Saturday 11 September, 2010. This also applies to the reserve day on Sunday 12 September.

Ground Entrance Regulations:

FOR YOUR SAFETY:

1. In the interest of safety, all spectators' bags will be searched on entering the ground.
2. Alcohol, metal cans, metal objects or glass containers may not be brought into the ground.
3. No large flag poles or sticks are allowed into the ground. Umbrellas are allowed.
4. We would like to remind all fans that entry on to the playing area before, during and following the match is strictly forbidden.
5. Please respect the "No Smoking" policy within all internal areas.
6. Please retain your match ticket at all times during the day. If you wish to leave the ground you must have your ticket for readmission to the ground.
7. In the event of an emergency it may be necessary to evacuate the ground. Please listen to PA announcements and follow the directions of the Stewards in your area.
8. Please do not leave your bags unattended in any part of the ground.
9. In the interest of other spectators, walking in front of seated spectators is not permitted during the over. It is requested that movement out of seats occur in between overs.
10. Should you require any help or assistance during your visit please contact the nearest steward.
11. Racist abuse and other gratuitously offensive abuse towards players, officials and other spectators are not part of the game and will attract the attention of stewards and the police and will almost certainly result in ejection from the ground.
12. The Event organisers reserve the right to refuse entry to any person carrying or wearing any items or substances that may be deemed to be offensive, disruptive, dangerous or likely to infringe any party's rights or any party's safety or security or any dangerous article or substance not referred to above. The Event Authority also reserves the right to deny entry to any person who in the opinion of the Safety Officer poses a threat to the safety of spectators in the ground or whose presence poses a threat to public order.
